

5.- CAREERS ADVISER

I am the Careers Adviser in the Counselling Department. The Counselling Department is the organism on which the school counts to do one of the most essential tasks within the institution itself: cope with diversity. Social diversity can be seen within our school, and in the Counselling Department we have two main goals: on the one hand, we need to respond to the individual characteristics of our male and female students, according to their abilities, to their knowledge. And, on the other hand, we co-ordinate with all the teachers so that, together as a team, we can provide each of our students with the best possible response to their needs.

Our objective means that our work is basically teamwork: teamwork both with tutors and with teachers in the various departments. Our job as a team requires that we provide answers through curricular adaptation to the individual needs of the different kinds of students – less able students, those who learn slower, those with less knowledge...

Another of the tasks for the Counselling Department is individual attention for each of the male and female students at school. Therefore when in doubt about your career, about the relationship with your classmates, about the relationship with your teachers, you can come individually to the Careers Adviser, who will counsel you and provide you with the best possible answers.
