

16.- MUSIC TEACHER

Music is a universal language knowing no languages or borders. It is one of the main pillars for people's cultural identity, a means of communication which is able to bring together different cultures under a common umbrella of understanding and relations.

Through the four years of compulsory education, and for two hours a week, we are going to work on interpersonal relationships, on creativity, on group production.

What do we want to achieve with this? We want to educate our students in the pleasure of music.

In the first and second years, we will focus on the knowledge of musical language, tunes, rhythms, forms, and we will introduce different musical instruments.

In the third year, we will journey through the history of music and see its link to historical happenings. Lastly, in the fourth year, we will study world music.

We need to count on suitable material to be able to run all the class activities: we have a piano, guitars, flutes, percussion, and within percussion what we call "hors" material – small percussion instruments such as xylophones.
