

## **19.- ETHICS**

My name is José Luis, and I teach Ethics, which is taught in the fourth year of CSE. It is a subject that all pupils take in which we try to find moral connectors through the study of values, the study of social relationships, not only in our culture, but also in others.

We work on individual ethical issues, social ethics and current moral problems. For those current moral problems, we establish debates through participation activities in class, especially the connection of our students with other cultures. We study this connection through principles such as solidarity, respect towards others, etc.

These activities become definite, like, for instance, today, in a series of debates on other issues related to the interaction of people belonging to different cultures. Thus, for example, we debate the influence of prejudices and preconceived ideas on our interpretation of cultures which are not our own.

This means that pupils will understand that we always interpret things from the point of view of our culture and that it would be a good idea to see things from another point of view. This will lead to a far more friendly relationship with classmates coming from abroad and far fewer conflicts.
